

Choosing A Garage Size

Looking for a garage but not sure what size you need? There are a few questions you need to ask yourself to help determine the proper size. First things first, the dimensions quoted to you are referring to the outside of the garage; the inside will be 6-8" smaller.

Second, determine the use of the garage. If you are storing a vehicle in the garage, measure the vehicle. The minimum suggested lengths are as follows:

Car: 14'

Small pick up: 18'

Full size pick up or equivalent: 20' or 22'

Now if you plan on using the garage to store a vehicle and use the space for other things you must consider the space it will take up. A 24'-28' building will be good for a vehicle and a work area with a bench or similar.

Also consider that if you need to store a vehicle and use the garage as a workspace you can upgrade to a 2 story garage. The 2nd floor has stairs that go up and the entire floor is open to use as a workshop or for storage.

All of our garages can be built with the wood floor omitted and be built on concrete floors. We can do the concrete work or you can have someone do it.
